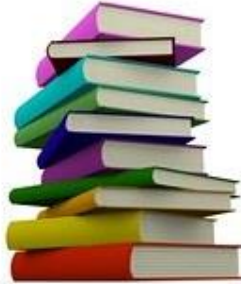
Citizenship Award
