Snacks are 25p per day (£1.25 per week) and lunch is £2.60 per day (£13.00 per week) - please pay in advance of the week ahead or provide your child with a snack / packed lunch.

Please check your account over the weekend, and if in arrears make a payment to bring it up to date with enough credit until the end of term.
