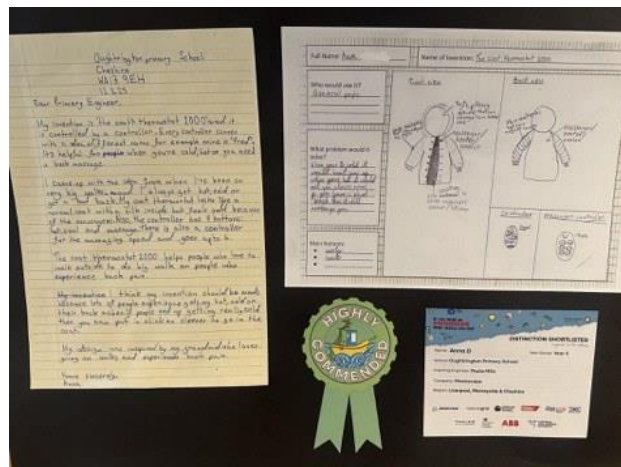

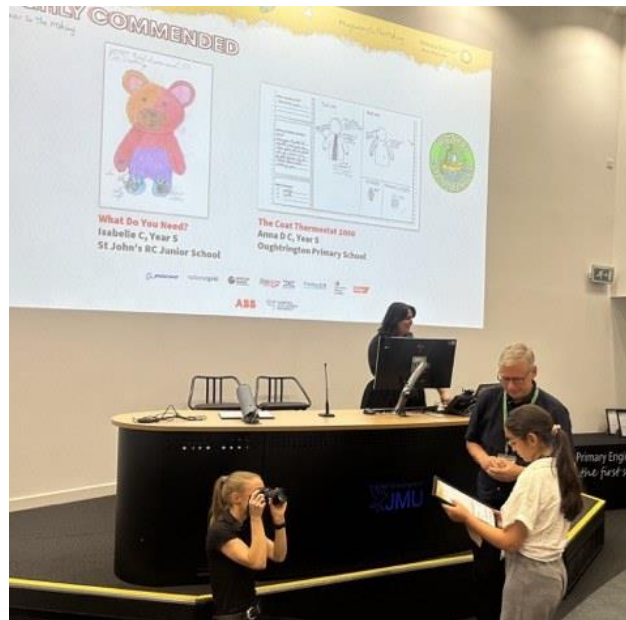
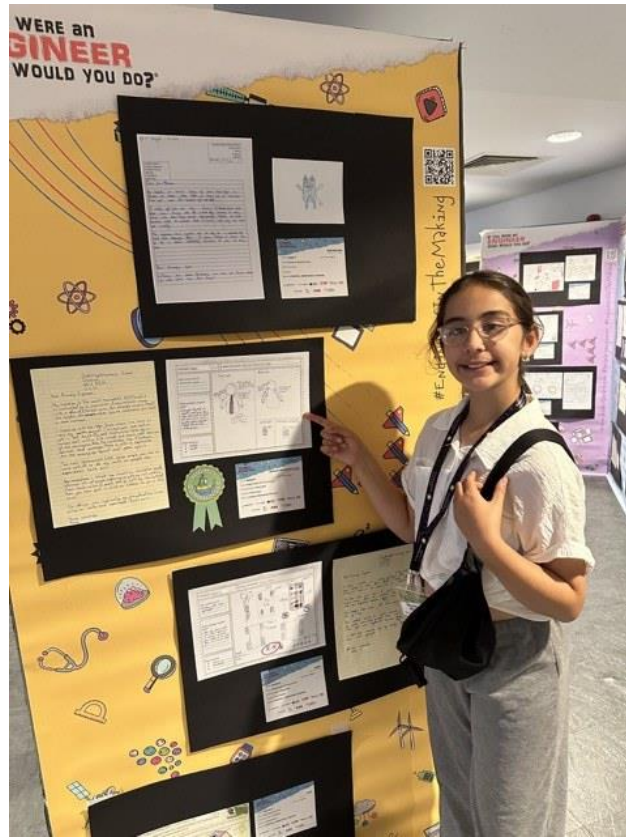
Congratulations to one of our Year 5 Pupils

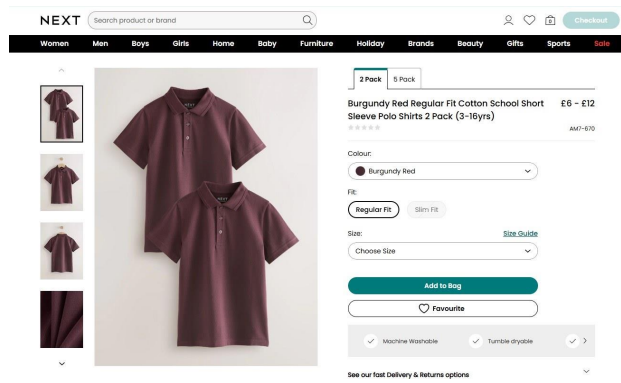

## Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR) Vaccine Letter

Dear parents/guardians/carers

**Re: Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) Vaccine**

**Measles is on the rise in Cheshire & Merseyside – please make sure your child has received two doses of the Measles, Mumps, & Rubella (MMR) vaccine for full protection.**

Measles is an infection that spreads very easily and can cause serious problems in some people. Having the MMR vaccine is the best way to prevent it. Babies and pregnant women are at increased risk of harm.

Measles symptoms to be aware of include:

- high fever
- sore, red, watery eyes
- coughing
- small greyish-white spots in the mouth
- aching and feeling generally unwell
- a blotchy red brown rash, which usually appears after the initial symptoms.

Anyone with symptoms is advised to stay at home and phone their GP or NHS 111 for advice, rather than visiting the surgery or A&E, to prevent the illness spreading further. Do not send your child to school or childcare.

The free MMR vaccine is a safe and effective way of protecting against measles, as well as mumps and rubella. Having two doses of the MMR vaccine at the right time, dose 1 from 12 months, and dose 2 from 3 years 4 months, is the best way to protect your child and help prevent the spread of measles. Especially to those most vulnerable.

Please make sure your child is up to date with their vaccinations. Ask at your GP surgery if you're not sure if you or your child has had the vaccine, you can also check your child's Red Book.

If you think you or your child may have only had 1 dose of the vaccine, please speak to your GP to get fully vaccinated. It is never too late to catch up. You can be vaccinated at any age.

## FRENCH CLUB AT OUGHTRINGTON



### About the French Club

Les Copains is a French club that runs every Monday lunchtime and Thursday after school. We introduce French in a fun way by exploring the language through games and activities. Sessions are designed using detailed lesson plans that are structured to stimulate children's natural enthusiasm for language. At Key Stage Two the focus shifts towards writing skills and grammar although the emphasis remains on learning in a fun and stimulating way.

The Les Copains formula has proved to be hugely popular with children of all ages and ability. It doesn't matter if your child has had no previous exposure to the French language, the programme is designed with a lot of repetition and children soon pick up the basics from the activities.

Our three stage approach to learning begins in pre-school at age 3. It's never too early to introduce a second language, in fact, research has shown the earlier the better.

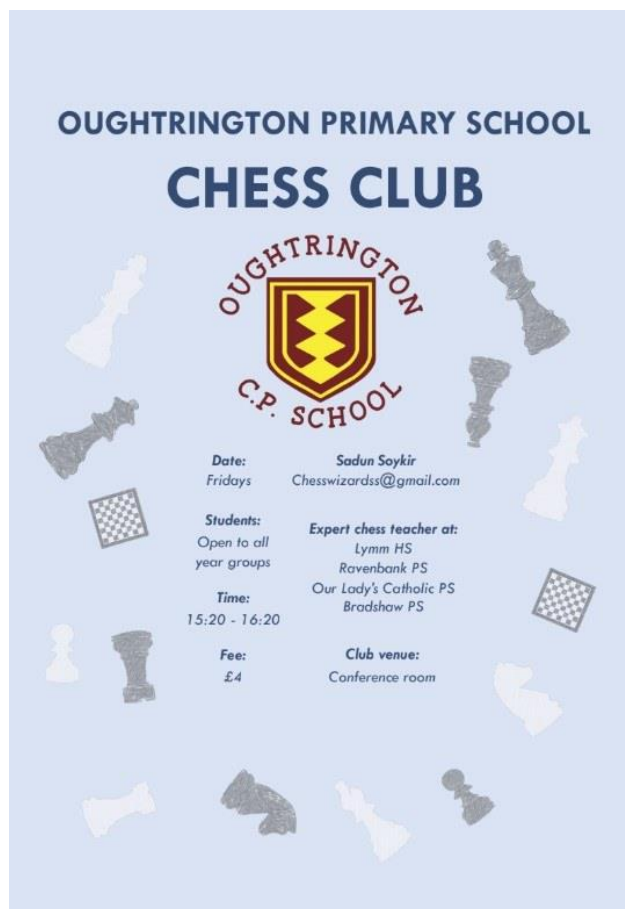

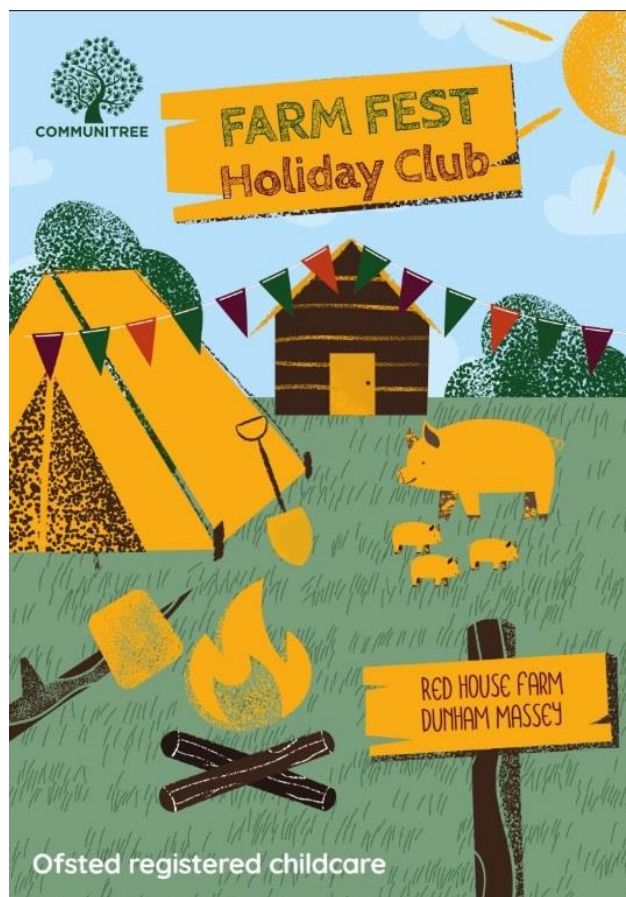
